Our initiatives include:


1. **Building on Pedagogical Practices**
 - Targeted professional development for all new teaching staff and follow-up PD for previously trained teaching staff on Tactical Teaching – supporting EIA – reading comprehension/cognitions
2. **Student Wellbeing**
 - Support ongoing student wellbeing framework to support all student wellbeing
 - Continue to fund the School Chaplain one day per fortnight to support student social/emotional needs
3. **Improve Student Outcomes**
 - Increase teacher aide hours to support the academic success of all students
 - Continue with our Indigenous Youth Worker program (approximately 30% Indigenous students).
 - Information Technology infrastructure upgrade including, server space, wireless upgrade and additional computer lab

Increase teacher aide hours to support the increase in students with learning difficulties at the school	\$ 53,397.00
IT infrastructure upgrade and additional computer lab	\$ 48,500.00
